B. DISCUSSION ITEMS

B.1 Councilor Investigation, Due Process, and Discipline--Open Session

This is an open session. Originally called as an executive session under LCMC 2.04.170 B and ORS 192.660(2)(b) to consider the dismissal or disciplining of, or to hear complaints or charges brought against, a public officer, employee, staff member or individual agent who does not request an open hearing.

Pursuant to the Attorney General's Public Meetings Manual, Part II, Section E(1)(b): "Although the provision requires an "open hearing" if the person involved so requests, we do not construe this provision to require an adversarial hearing, but only an open session. The affected person need not be present and has no right to postpone the hearing to permit an attorney to attend or to have a formal hearing, unless another law, a contract, or a collective bargaining agreement provides those rights."
